2-Location:

Northwest corner of the intersection of West Market Street and North Front Street, near the Square, Georgetown, Sussex County, Delaware.

Brief Statement
of Significance:

This small office is a dependency characteristic of the period for the town houses of lawyers and physicians, though generally annexed to the main body of the house.

History:

Erected presumably about 1809 when the house with which it is associated was built.

Description:

Cyprus-shingled frame building, small rectangular front block plus rear wing, three bays wide, one story, gabled roof, simple detail.
