

SIGNIFICANCE (ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL, INCLUDE ORIGINAL USE OF STRUCTURE) The Ferguson House was an existing private residence acquired by the Navy in 1902. Architecturally it is significant as an example of indigenous Key West domestic architecture which contributed to the character of the residential area on the Naval Station.		
STYLE (IF APPROPRIATE) two-story, side gabled wood frame vernacular		
MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION (INCLUDE STRUCTURAL SYSTEMS) wood frame		
SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (SKETCHED FLOOR PLANS ON SEPARATE PAGES ARE ACCEPTABLE) 2 story, 36'- 6" x 43' x 10'- 3"H (1,968 sq. ft.)		
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE A portion of the original roofline is visible to the left fo the front upstairs window.		
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED) The first floor contains a central living area with fireplace, surrounded in 3 sides by a louvered porch, kitchen and dining areas. A stairway exists at what was the original rear wall. Upstairs there are two bedrooms and a louvered porch area.		
MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES After Navy acquisition the surrounding grade was raised so that the stone foundation walls (8'high) became below grade. One-story additions were added on 3 sides between 1906 and 1910 and a second story was later (exact date unknown) added.		
PRESENT CONDITION AND USE Extensive and serious water damage. Presently vacant.
