Owner: Three Consos Brothers in California own No. 118,
Dr. Oliveros owns 124.

Date of Erection: 1860.

Builder: Both built by two brothers.

Present Condition: Good.

Number of Stories: Three. Faces South.

Materials of Construction: Brick foundation, wood floors,
exterior walls of brick.

Additional Data: Black Italian marble mantels, mahogany
stair rail and newel; plaster cornice and frieze and cen-
ter piece in parlow and dining room. Wide pine board floors.

Reference Mrs. J. C. Wilson, who rents both houses.

This double house arrangement with steps
in opposite direction leading to entrance stoop high above
ground is typical of a number of examples in Savannah.
