ST PAUL'S PARISH CEMETERY
Augusta, Richmond County, Georgia

Owner: St Paul's Parish; Episcopal.

Date of Erection: 1800 - 1850.

Present Condition: Lettering almost worn away by weather in some cases; in other cases well preserved.

Materials of Construction: Wall of brick; original coating of stucco has fallen away; gate iron; gravestones of marble or stone; in some cases sandstone.

Other Existing Records: Records 14-41 by P. Thornton Marye, District Officer H.A.B.S. 1934. Records in the Parish House; Georgia's Landmarks, Memorials & Legends, by Knight; History of St. Paul's, by C. C. Williams; Garden History of Georgia.

Additional Data: Built on site of old Fort; fighting took place here during the Revolutionary War. No Gravestones which date back to this era were observed.
