Date of Erection: 1833-36.

Present Condition: Fair. South exterior wrought iron wall supports put in about forty years ago according to Mr. Bob Meaders.

Number of Stories: Two.

Materials of Construction: Brick foundation, brick exterior walls, metal roof.

Other Existing Records: Georgia Homes and Landmarks. Ref. Prof. A. W. Cain who wrote " Skyline, History of Lumpkin County."

Additional Data: Crude tapered stucco on brick two story columns in front (S. East) supporting roof over second story porch. Gable roof with two oblique oval vents in gable. Brick were made on farm on Col. Baker in Yahoola Valley about one mile from Dahlonega.
