## HISTORIC AMERICAN BUILDINGS SURVEY

SMITH HOUSE

### Location:

The Smith House is located at 120 Adair Street in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia. This address is located on the east side of Adair Street, north of Richardson Street in the Wagner Heights neighborhood.

### Significance:

The Smith House is historically significant in the areas of architecture and community development. Architecturally, it is an example of a house type represented frequently in the Wagner Heights neighborhood. It also contributes to an understanding of early twentieth century urban development due to its role in the Wagner Heights neighborhood.

### Description:

This one story, rectangular wood frame house appears frequently in the Wagner Heights neighborhood, although it is not representative of a recognized vernacular house type. It has a rectangular main mass under a hipped roof, a recessed partial front porch with a single Craftsman inspired porch support, exposed rafters, and one over one double hung sash windows. The interior features drywall, one mantel and a long narrow hallway with access to the bedrooms.

### History:

This residence, built c. 1915, is one of five residences built by Mr. Gunther.



