
## HISTORIC AMERICAN BUILDINGS SURVEY

### JAUDON-BRAGG-SNELLING-FARM (Barn)

HABS No. GA-2298-B

- Location:** The north side of Georgia State Route 21, northwest of Ebenezer Creek and southeast of Springfield, Springfield Vicinity, Effingham County, Georgia.
- Significance:** The Jaudon-Bragg-Snellings Farm is historically significant in the area of agriculture as representative of Southern rural farming methods, and architecture as representative of the saddlebag house type.
- Description:** The four crib barn is ca. 1913. The outstanding characteristic of this barn is its log construction. The barn is also a ca. 1913 outbuilding. The single crib barn has a shed addition. The building is of wood construction and has a tin covered large sloping gable roof.
- History:** Henry Jaudon built the house and barn on a 100 acre tract. The house was later sold to Watson Bragg, who lived on the property from about 1928 to the early 1960s. On twenty acres of the property, he farmed corn and cotton. The house is now owned and occupied by Charles and Joyce Snelling.
