Location:

The Young House is located at Ridgedale Park Lakeside/Kingsboro Neighborhood, 3536 Roxboro Road in Fulton County, in the City of Atlanta, Georgia.

Significance:

The Young House is historically significant as an intact example of a c.1940 minimal traditional style house. It possesses a local level of significance in the area of architecture.

Description:

The Young House is a representative example of a minimal traditional style house. It possesses an intact floor plan consisting of a living room, dining room, kitchen and two small bedrooms off of a back hallway. Architectural features of interest include a brick veneer exterior, a side gable roof, 8/8 windows and a pedimented front entry. There is also an attached garage, which is common for the period. Interior features include a living room fireplace and mantle.

History:

The Young House was built c.1940 as part of the Ridgedale Park Lakeside/Kingsboro neighborhood, which is an example of a 1920s to 1940s American suburban development. This area was originally considered to be in the country and was developed with the automobile in mind. The house had several owners until it was purchased by the Young family in 1960. The Young family continues to reside in the home.


