


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

- Significance: The U.S. Naval Base at Pearl Harbor was designated as a National Historic Landmark in 1964. As a Category 3 structure, it has been determined that Building No. 985 functioned as part of the Pearl Harbor Naval Base, but is only of minor importance to the historic character of the National Historic Landmark.
- Description: Building No. 985 is a semi-permanent wooden structure of approximately 3,800 square feet.
- History: Building No. 985 was built as a baseball dugout/grandstand facility in 1949 at a cost of \$18,104. Building No. 985 is currently not in use because it is termite-eaten and deteriorated. Complete demolition is planned for this structure. There are no plans to repair or rebuild Building No. 985 in the future.
