Significance: The U.S. Naval Base at Pearl Harbor was designated as a National Historic Landmark in 1964. Building No. 85 is an uncategorized structure of the Pearl Harbor Naval Base, and is only of minor importance to the historic character of the National Historic Landmark.

Description: Building No. 85 is a semi-permanent, wooden structure of approximately 487 square feet.

History: Building No. 85 was built as a detached carport for Quarters 1039 in 1914 at a cost of \$300. The structure is constructed similarly to other carports along Hale Alii Road. Quarters 1039 is a Craftsman Style wood-frame, two-story structure and was one of six original officer's quarters planned for the Navy Shipyard. The Craftsman Style was inspired by the work of Greene and Greene in Pasadena, California, and popularized through magazines, in particular, Gustav Stickley's The Craftsman, published between 1901 and 1916. The Spalding Construction Company in Portland, Oregon, was the general contractor.

The Navy proposes repair by replacement of Building 85, which is structurally unstable due to significant termite damage. The replacement will be in the same architectural style.


