Naval Submarine Base at Moore Street, within the triangular peninsula between Quarry Loch and Magazine Loch.
Pearl Harbor, City and County of Honolulu, Hawaii

Significance:

The Naval Base at Pearl Harbor was designated as a National Historic Landmark in 1964, due to the crucial role it played in the Nation's defense during the twentieth century and the calamitous events which occurred on December 7, 1941. As a Category 3 facility, it has been determined that Building No. 628 functioned as part of the Pearl Harbor Naval Base, and is only of minor importance to the historic character of the National Historic Landmark.

Description:

Building 628 is a one-story masonry structure with steel roof truss and corrugated metal roofing. The building is 62 feet wide, 135 feet long and 27 feet high with a total floor area of approximately 7,956 square feet

History:

Building 628 was constructed in 1931 for use as a Theater. Later during 1944 to 1951, several improvement projects added stage wings and curtains, toilets and a projection booth to the theater.
