Significance: The U.S. Naval Base, Pearl Harbor was designated as a National Historic Landmark in 1964. As a Category 3 structure, it is determined that Building 93 functioned as a part of the Pearl Harbor Naval Base, but is only of minor importance to the historic character of the National Landmark.

Description: Building 93 is a semi-permanent, one story, 8799 square foot, wood frame structure consisting of concrete footings (foundation); wood frame, flooring, roof trusses and exterior walls; wood window frames with jalousies and sliding windows; and wood exterior doors.

History: Building 93 was constructed in 1943 to serve as an identification (ID) office at a cost of \$129,378. In 1983, the building became occupied by the Alcohol Rehabilitation Center, and classrooms and offices were set up for training\counseling active duty military with drug and/or alcohol problems. The Alcohol Rehabilitation Center was disestablished in October 1994. The existing building is deteriorated with extensive termite damage and is planned for demolition.
