Location: Building 442 is located at the north end of Kuahua Avenue, Fleet Industrial Supply Center, Pearl Harbor, Honolulu County, Hawaii.

Significance: The Naval Base at Pearl Harbor was designated as a National Historic Landmark in 1964, due to the crucial role it played in the Nation's defense during the twentieth century and the calamitous events which occurred on December 7, 1941. Building 442 is determined to be of minor importance to the historic character of the National Historic Landmark.

Description: Building 442 is a vacant, single story, 1,797 square feet, rectangular facility with metal/asbestos siding and roofing, and a wood and metal frame structure on a concrete pier foundation. It is 25 feet wide, 61 feet long and 17 feet high. The interior and exterior elements of the building are not significant in terms of historical or architectural characteristic.


History: Building 442 was built in 1922 at a cost of \$12,291. Originally constructed as a small arms ammunition storehouse, it was converted to administration storage in circa 1942. Currently, the building is vacant due to health/safety concerns of asbestos insulation and peeling lead paint, and due to deteriorated conditions beyond economical repair.
