Roelofsz, Dr. Joost, House (Viersen House) (IA-32)

Structure

1008-10 Main St. (originally Reformation Ave.). Stuccoed brick, central black with side kitchen and office wings, one-and-a-half stories, steep gambrel roofs, wooden trellis porches, applied Gothic details. Built 1848 by Dr. Roelofsz, one of original Dutch immigrants to Pella and town's first doctor. House contained his office and painting studio. Remained in daughter's (Viersen)
