
ID-105-20 VIEW OF RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS TAKEN IN 1911 LOOKING NORTHEAST PROBABLY FROM SWAN FALLS DAM. FROM LEFT TO RIGHT, RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS ARE COTTAGE 101, THE COTTAGE THAT BURNED IN 1921 (AND WAS REPLACED WITH COTTAGE 231), AND THE CLUB HOUSE. OTHER BUILDINGS IN FOREGROUND ARE STOREHOUSES AND SHOPS.

ID-105-21 VIEW OF COTTAGE 101 AND THE SWAN FALLS POWER PLANT AND DAM TAKEN AROUND 1920, LOOKING SOUTHWEST. BUILDING AT LOWER LEFT IS COTTAGE THAT LATER BURNED.



ID-105-23 VIEW TAKEN OF VILLAGE, DAM, AND POWER HOUSE AROUND 1945. CAMERA IS PROBABLY ON ROAD LEADING INTO VILLAGE AND FACES SOUTHWEST. CLUB HOUSE IS AT LOWER LEFT, WITH COTTAGES 361, 362, AND 363 TO THE RIGHT OF IT ON THE SAME SIDE OF THE ROAD. COTTAGE 231 SHOWS WASHING ON THE CLOTHESLINE. COTTAGE 101 AT LOWER RIGHT.




