Location: 631 Nineteenth Street  
Russell National Register District  
Louisville, Jefferson County Kentucky

Significance: 631 Nineteenth Street is significant within the context of the Russell National Register District which was listed in 1980. This structure is typical of commercial buildings that were built throughout this particular neighborhood (as well as throughout Louisville) during the early 20th century.

Description: 631 Nineteenth Street is a two-story folk style building. The building is frame construction with shingle siding in brick pattern. Existing siding is installed over wood lapped siding. Lower story has been modified to add an entry at a 45 degree angle at the corner. Alterations to building after its initial construction include window awnings and doors for sub dividing the building into apartments.

History: This structure was first occupied by A. Ford & Son Grocers in 1926. In later years it was occupied by a series of laborers and tradesmen and their families.






