- MA-1256-H-1 General exterior north elevation, main facade, roof etc., view to south
- MA-1256-H-2 Exterior detail, north facade, one of few intact doors, this one is at east end of north side of building
- MA-1256-H-3 General oblique exterior view from southwest to northeast, showing rear addition and one of two outside-access entrances to basement
- MA-1256-H-4 Oblique view to rear showing enclosed rear addition
- MA-1256-H-5 Oblique general view of east and north elevations, view to southwest
- MA-1256-H-6 Interior, attic room at east end of building, view to west showing knee wall, roof rafters, decking and truss bracing
- MA-1256-H-7 Basement interior detail showing access to exterior, pointed granite foundation walls, brick column supporting timber beam, floor joists (concrete floor is not original), view is west to east
