**HABS No. MA-1325**

Location: 8 Walnut Street, Boston, Suffolk County, Massachusetts. This house is part of the Beacon Hill National Historic Landmark District.

Significance: Little is known about this building, other than it is representative of the domestic architecture found within the Beacon Hill Historic District. It was constructed in 1811. Historically the building was associated with Uriah Cotting and Nathaniel Pope Russell.<sup>1</sup>

Materials: There are field measurements for No. 8 Walnut Street; these are dated September of 1932. They are not signed.
