Location: Not specified, Manchester, Essex County, Massachusetts.

Materials: At the time of the survey (June of 1938), the house was occupied by Mrs. David Cheever.¹ The (eclectic) field notes for the building also include a profile of the "church balcony rail" and a typescript reference to the retrofitting of a building for a cafe.

¹ The Massachusetts Cultural Resource Information System catalogued three "Cheever Houses" in Manchester, but it is unknown at this time if any match the field notes here. The inventory numbers for the MACRIS database are MAN.55 (the Bennett Street house, ca. 1765); MAN.142 (2 Desmond Avenue, ca. 1800); and MAN.135 (24 School Street, ca. 1808).
