INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED) Double staircase in central hall which replaces the original staircase.			
MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES 1817-1820 front entrance rebuilt after British burned house in 1813; plan changed somewhat in 1820 restoration; late 19th century alterations when house made hotel during 1890's; restored in 20th century.
