"Old Bartold Grove"

This old building located on Manchester & Hanley Roads, Maplewood, St. Louis County, Missouri, was built in the year 1826 by Henry Barthold who came from Germany and settled in this section which was later called "Bartold Valley".

The building as it now stands is in its original state. Very few, if any, changes have ever been made.

It is a three story brick and stone structure with hip roof with dormers. Brick pilaster on facade. Stone lintels.
