"Thomas Smith Home"

This residence located in Mokane, Calloway County, Missouri, was erected between the years 1830 and 1835 by Thomas Smith, one of the pioneers of Calloway County.

The brick used in the construction of the residence was made by hand by slave labor.

Thomas Smith served the Country in the Revolutionary War.

The residence is a two story brick structure with a frame siding addition.
