The film used for HABS MO-1930-1 thru -26 is Ilford HP-5, a widely acceptable film. The photographer developed the film in PYRO developer, a chemical that dates into the 1850's or 60's. It is a stain developer that enhances the silver image by the stain deposit which is olive green, the color of the negatives.

The films have no noticeable aroma of hypo. I have administered the standard test for traces of residual hypo and found the test negative, (MO-1930-25) excellent, with no trace of staining from the test solution at two minutes.
