NUMBER OF STORIES: ONE STORY and attic.

MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION: The exterior walls are of brick, with local limestone foundation. Interior steel ceiling and plaster walls. Trim exterior of Conncticut Brown Stone. Concrete and cement steps. Wood shingle roof. Wood floors. Wood wainscoting, blackboards of artificial compo board painted. Doors and trim, also windows are of white pine. Doors are of various types of paneling, some being moulded on the solid, others perfectly plain without moldings. Ordinary iron hardware

OTHER EXISTING RECORDS: The attendance records show that this school is one of the oldest in Rensselaer County and was attended by President Garfield as a boy. This is about its only significance.

ADDITIONAL DATA: There is no doubt but what this building will eventually become extinct as the community or centralized schools and buses for transportation become more popular in this vicinity.
