OWNER: Landers, present owners and occupants.

DATE OF ERECTION: 1815-25.

ARCHITECT: None.

PRESENT CONDITION: Fair. Several mantels and typical cupboards have been removed and destroyed by an unappreciative owner. This old home is very similar to the Whallon residence (O-617). The window lintels (appearing white in the photograph) are brick. The main entrance also has a brick arch.

ADDITIONAL DATA: This home was built by the Harrison and Armstrong families (related through marriage) who owned a considerable portion of the land in this area and also operated several mills.

All information about the building is very obscured. The present owner and S. E. Durham, (Newtown, Ohio) are the only sources of information.
