SIGNIFICANCE (ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL, INCLUDE ORIGINAL USE OF STRUCTURE) The Wolf Building is a good example of an early twentieth century commercial structure. Its upper three stories (a later addition) incorporate motifs from the original building.		
STYLE (IF APPROPRIATE) Second Renaissance Revival		
MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION (INCLUDE STRUCTURAL SYSTEMS) Steel pier with brick facing and wood floor joists and flooring. Roof is composition on wood framing.		
SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (SKETCHED FLOOR PLANS ON SEPARATE PAGES ARE ACCEPTABLE) Modified rectangular shape; 63'x157'; 8 stories plus basement		
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE First floor facade has a rusticated stone storefront and simple cornice. Upper floor windows have plain stone lintels, except for the fourth floor which has brick arches with keystones. Bricks are laid in a rusticated pattern above these windows to the seventh floor. Decorated metal cornices accent the top of the fifth and seventh floors. Decorative stone panels applied between windows on top floor.		
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED) Polygonal and rounded stone factory sinks.		
MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES Altered in 1946, adding floors 6-8.
