- Location: 622 Front Street, Portsmouth, Scioto County, Ohio
- Significance: The Peter Kinney House is an unusual example in Portsmouth of a vernacular structure that is also architecturally ambitious.
- Description: This symmetrical, rectangular house with hipped roof shows the influence of Palladio. The neoclassic Ionic porch has been partially rebuilt. A widow's walk on the roof was removed before 1880.
- History: The Peter Kinney House was built in 1832.
