Washington County Old Men's Home, Bakery Building

- Location:** 2198 North Main Street
Arden Vicinity
Washington County
Pennsylvania, 15301

- Significance:** Located on the same parcel as Main Building (HABS No. PA-5585-A), a contributing structure to the complex. This structure was built circa 1922 as a bakery in support of the Washington County Old Men's Home. It is an example of Utilitarian style architecture.
- Description:** A free standing building constructed of structural clay tile with a terra cotta facing. The building is two stories in height. It is two bays wide and six bays in depth. There was a two bay addition added to the north gable end.
- The roof is gable construction with returns on the ends. The roof is covered with slate. There is a brick chimney in the center at the ridge.
- The original front section has two over two double hung wood sash and the rear addition has nine over nine metal casement sash. The entrance door is the north gable end.
- The interior has a large brick oven located in the center of the first floor.
- The walls and ceilings are plastered. The interior floors are wood. There is flat plain casing around the door and window openings.
- History:** This building was built circa 1922 as a bakery for the institution. The bakery building was continuously used as a bakery until shortly before the Washington County Old Men's Home facility was vacated in 1976. It has been vacant ever since.




