Structure Fort Belknap (TEX-33-D-7)

3 miles S. on Tex. 251. County Park. Stone, one-story structures made up this fort, established by the U.S. Army in 1851 as an outpost against Indians and abandoned in 1859 except for a brief reactivation in 1867. A team from HABS measured the site in 1934, marking the locations of ruined buildings and making drawings of a 20' x 71' forage building and a 16' x 22' magazine. Both buildings were sufficiently intact to be restored as
(over)

part of a 1936 reconstruction project but other buildings and roads were rebuilt with no apparent reference to original locations. 3 sheets (1936, including site plan, plans, elevations, section); 12 ext. photos (1934, 6 of each building); 1 data page (1934). NR.
