Additional Data:

This three room house was built by Joe Kyresh, an early Polish settler in this community. Original portion of house was built of native stone, quarried several miles from building site. The brick wing on the West side, or rear, was a later addition.

East porch is typical of the early houses built by the Polish settlers of this particular community. Southwest porch is part of the later addition.

Attic is accessible only from outside, by means of ladder thru trap door on South side. Floors, ceilings, interior, trim, etc., are of native oak and pine. Original owner was Mathew Urbanczyk.
