209 E. Broadway. Frame with clapboarding, L-shaped, five-bay front, one-and-a-half stories, gabled roof with central attic gable; on west facade, hexastyle Doric portico shelters elaborately carved entrance with sidelights and fan-shaped pediment, four floor-length windows, and a corner pilaster opposite each end column; on the southeast, an L-shaped portico with seven square columns connects main section and rear wing.
