Tooele County Courthouse and City Hall

Vine St. just east of State Rt. 36. Museum. Red sandstone, uncoursed rubble masonry; rectangular, 27'-3" (three-bay front) x 66'-5", one story divided into two levels at rear, gabled roof with heavy wooden cornice and belfry ornamented with spindlework. Built 1867, belfry added after 1874, served as courthouse and city hall until 1899 and as city hall only until 1941. Since 1942 maintained by the Daughters of Utah Pioneers as a
