The airmen's dormitory was constructed in 1944. The construction was of a temporary design with a wood foundation, wood floor, and wood walls. The roof is of asphalt roll construction. The heating source was originally individual coal fired space heaters. It is a 2,020-square-foot-building of 20-foot-by-101-foot dimensions.

This building is identical in use, plan, and appearance as 2511, 2512, 2513, 2514, 2505 with the exception (as in the case of building 2504) there is no covered porch. The building has a capacity of 24. The original construction cost was \$3,200. The building appears to be structurally sound.




