Shop

This structure is a small wood frame, wood sided shop located just west of the large barn (structure UT-126-A). The shop has a gabled roof covered with wood shingles. The long axis of the building is oriented north to south. A large set of swinging double doors nearly fills the south wall of the shop. A small window covered by a board is located near the center of the west wall.
