Additional Data: Gambrel roof, shed dormers, two end chimneys, central double door, one window on each side, 9/9 sash, brick flat arches. One room wings at either end, later. Hall has old dado, but stair is c.1800, as are the mantels in rooms. One large room either side of hall with sheathed dado and small dentil cornice. Windows have splays to floor, sheathed reveals, plan: 

Mantels probably from Baltimore. Engaged Doric columns, elliptical in plan, delicate architrave with gouged ornament, also sunburst motives in end and key blocks. Cornice has dentils with guilloche between: 

House has wide terrace in front with a wide view overlooking the Rappahannock River in the distance.
