Brick, Flemish bond; all headers glazed, story and a half; gable roof; inside end-chimneys; front three bays; center door; sash 9/9 lights, now missing; two shed dormers on roof, 6/6 lights. Plan--two unequal rooms; front and rear doors enter larger, and stair ascends from same; partition now destroyed. Stair closed string, turned balusters, original gray-blue paint. Both fireplaces about 5 by 7 feet, openings with wood rolled mouldings. Both mantels now removed; one cut down and re-erected in modern dwelling nearby.
