FORT HILL FARM, Small Barn

HABS NO. VA-1288-K

- LOCATION: West of the Staunton (Roanoke) River between Turkey Run and Caesar's Run, Clover Vicinity, Halifax County, Virginia
- SIGNIFICANCE: This building contributes to Fort Hill by its association with the farm's agricultural activities.
- DESCRIPTION: This building is a small, post-and-beam barn sheathed with vertical board siding. Both the lumber and the nails are modern. Galvanized, corrugated seam roofing covers the front-gable roof. The tongue-in-groove floor is laid on sleepers set directly on the ground. A wooden partition divides the interior into two spaces. The west space is filled with hay; the east space has an assortment of nails and hooks on the wall and may have been used as a tack room.
- HISTORY: The construction date of this barn is not known.
