LOCATION: West Side of State Route 600, .8 mile North of State Route 778, Clover Vicinity, Halifax County, Virginia

SIGNIFICANCE: This domestic outbuilding is a contributing element of Edgewood Farm.

DESCRIPTION: This shed measures about 10' x 12'. It is of stud frame construction, with rough weatherboard siding. The front-gable roof is clad with seamed metal. The raised floor in the interior is fashioned from closely-set planking. A heavy vertical plank door in the southeast wall is hung on triangular iron strap hinges.

HISTORY: The date of this building is unknown.
