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| VA-1375-1 | General view, from the southeast across Interstate 395 in Pentagon City. |
| VA-1375-2 | General view, from the east with Wing 8 first in line at center. |
| VA-1375-3 | General view of Wings 7 and 8 from the north across Arlington Cemetery. |
| VA-1375-3 | Interior view of a private first-floor office (RM-18392) in Wing 8, from the southeast. |
| VA-1375-4 | General view of Wing 8 from the north across Arlington Cemetery. |
| VA-1375-5 | Perspective view from the northwest capturing Wing 8's main entrance and the north bridge connecting to Wing 7. |
| VA-1375-6 | Detail view, Wing 8 main entrance canopy and loggia. |
| VA-1375-7 | View from the south capturing Wing 7, Wing 8, and both connecting bridges. Note the garage at left, which was removed along with Wing 8 in the Fall 2004. |
| VA-1375-8 | View from the south capturing Wing 7, Wing 8, and both connecting bridges. |

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- VA-1375-12 View from the southeast capturing all eight wings, beginning with Wing 8. The large building behind FB 2 is a Sheraton hotel, located outside the precinct.
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- VA-1375-17 General view from an east-facing window on Wing 8's ground floor, looking out towards the Pentagon with Washington, D.C. beyond.
- VA-1375-18 General view from a south-facing window on Wing 8's ground floor, looking out across Columbia Pike and Interstate 395 toward Pentagon City beyond.
- VA-1375-19 Detail view, roundel depicting the Department of Defense, Missile Defense Agency logo, located in the "war gaming" room on Wing 8's second floor.
- VA-1375-20 General interior view, Wing 8's main lobby, known as the "access control center," from the southwest. This ground-floor space is located in the building's northwest corner.
- VA-1375-21 Interior view from the north, looking through the plate glass security doors in the access control center along the ground-floor corridor.
- VA-1375-22 Interior view of the front desk in the ground-floor information resource center, from the south.
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- VA-1375-24 Interior view of the copy/trash/recycling area at the center of the ground floor, from the north. This area is located adjacent to Stair 81. Note the double doors at right, which access a mechanical room (MG-822) depicted in HABS No. VA-1375-25.
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- VA-1375-30 Interior view of the ground-floor landing of Stair 82 located in Wing 8's southwest corner, from the east. The door with the "exit" sign is an at-grade exterior door. Note the braided canvas on the balustrade's vertical tubular supports.
- VA-1375-31 Detail view of Stair 82 balustrade near the ground-floor landing. The flight of stairs between the ground and first floors is embellished with canvas and roping. The railings are encased in canvas with a single seam running along their undersides. Braided rope is wound around the railing at points where it changes direction, and on either side of connections with the vertical support posts. The upper portions of the support posts are encased with woven canvas held in place with braided rope.
