Note: In the hospital's nomenclature, the corridors which connect the ward buildings at their centers and run in an east-west direction are called "Ramps." Corridors running in a north-south direction are called "Corridors." Standard Ward and Combination Ward buildings are divided at the ramps into A sections (south) and B sections (north).

HABS No. Description

- WA-202-12-1 Ramp No. 1 with west end of Building No. 9902 in background. Corner of Headquarters Building No. 9900 is on right. For view in opposite direction, see photo WA-202-1-2.
- WA-202-12-2 Ramp No. 3 connection between two Standard Wards: Building Nos. 9935-A (left) and 9934-A (right). Note asymmetrical wooden door, and brick arch above doorway.
- WA-202-12-3 Ramp No. 6 connection between Medical Detachment Barracks: Building Nos. 9970-B (left) and 9969-B (right). The many windows makes this section almost unique among the ramps and corridors.
- WA-202-12-4 Corridor B. Perspective of west side as viewed from roof of Building No. 9982. The flat-roof building that joins Corridor B is Building No. 9981, Receiving and Evacuation Building.
- WA-202-12-5 Corridor A and Building No. 9962-A (with white door). In upper left is east side of Building No. 9952-B.
- WA-202-12-6 Corridor A. Interior view looking north in hallway.

Note: The following drawing is from a series of 1942-1944 architectural drawings of a military "Mobilization General Hospital, Type A" made by architects/engineers York & Sawyer of New York, NY for the U.S. War Department, Construction Division.
