HABS No. Description

- WA-214-A-1 Aerial oblique view looking WSW shows Boat House left of center and seaplane ramp at water's edge on right. HABS negative is a 4x5" copy negative made from a 35mm color transparency taken by a Navy photographer in 1996.
- WA-214-A-2 Context view looking NE from bluff shows the back sides of the two wings of the Boat House: the N-S wing extending to the left and the E-W wing extending to the right. In the right foreground is the Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) Marina office. Behind that on the far right is Building 81.
- WA-214-A-3 Perspective view from water looking SE shows the front sides of the two wings of the Boat House: the E-W wing on the left and the N-S wing on the right.
- WA-214-A-4 Perspective view from water of NE corner of the E-W wing shows upper level office with windows.
- WA-214-A-5 Elevation view from water of north side of E-W wing. Upper level office seen in photo WA-214-A-3 is on far left. Part of N-S wing is on right.
- WA-214-A-6 Elevation view from pier of east side of N-S wing.
- WA-214-A-7 Elevation view from seaplane ramp of north end of N-S wing.
- WA-214-A-8 Elevation view from street of west side of Boat House. The long section without windows is the N-S wing. The shorter section with windows is the E-W wing.
- WA-214-A-9 Oblique view of back side of Boat House (looking NE) includes the entire south side and a small portion of the west side on left.
- WA-214-A-10 Oblique view at midsection of back side shows monorail crane structure linking Boat House to Building 81.
- WA-214-A-11 Oblique view looking SE at the upper office on the east end of the E-W wing. Windows on right look into covered boat bays.
- WA-214-A-12 Interior view of E-W wing looking west from walkway that leads to office shown in photo WA-214-A-11.

- WA-214-A-13 Interior view of E-W wing looking south from pier shows typical boat bay.
- WA-214-A-14 Winch attached to steel beam at upper level of west end of E-W wing. An identical winch behind camera is not shown.
- WA-214-A-15 Interior view of N-S wing looking north from south end.

NOTE: The following six HABS copy photographs are contact prints made from 8x10" high contrast copy negatives of original drawings in the collection of the Public Works Department, Building 12, Naval Air Station, Whidbey Island, Oak Harbor, WA. The 1942 drawings were in poor physical condition at the time of copying in 1996; nevertheless, the best possible copy negatives were made for HABS.
