Photographs WI-308-35 to WI-308-84 were copied from historic Army photographs at Fort McCoy. The original negatives and/or prints are on file in the DEH office at Fort McCoy. The majority are undated; all but a few date from 1940 to 1943, the period when most of the construction took place. Many were probably taken for progress or completion reports. Photographs WI-308-42 to WI-308-84 document buildings and structures in the oldest part of the installation, now called South Post, where many of the structures have been demolished.
