- HAER WY-2-1 View to top of dam from Canyon floor
- HAER WY-2-2 View down stream toward Generating Station, water flowing from penstock at left
- HAER WY-2-3 58 inch outlet abandoned at base of dam
- HAER WY-2-4 Dam from west side of Canyon
- HAER WY-2-5 Dam and valley from generating station
- HAER WY-2-6 View of dam from Canyon floor
- HAER WY-2-7 View of dam from Canyon floor, discharge spillway tunnel at middle right
- HAER WY-2-8 Headgate to east mountain tunnel
- HAER WY-2-9 Electric drive for operating two 48 inch valves at base of dam
- HAER WY-2-10 42 in valves for flushing 42 inch penstock below power house
- HAER WY-2-11 42 inch valve for flushing 42 in penstock
- HAER WY-2-12 58 inch valve control, bottom level
