DUNLAP RANCH, GARAGE

Location: Belle Ayr Coal Mine Permit Area, Gillette
vicinity, Campbell County, Wyoming.

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History and Description:

The garage (Feature G, see Photos WY-112-G-1 to WY-112-G-2) is a one-story, gable-roofed wood frame building (20' N-S x 20'5" E-W) resting on a concrete foundation. This building was constructed in the late 1920s or early 1930s. The roof has a gentle pitch, exposed rafter ends, and is covered with wood shingles. The exterior walls are covered with stucco painted white. There are two narrow wooden garage doors in the north elevation that tilt upward without bending on a system of pulleys, chains, and counterweights. There are a pair of two over two-light double-hung windows in the east and west elevations and a wood panel door in the south elevation. The interior walls are unfinished, and the garage has a dirt floor.
