Letter written by Alexander Graham Bell to his Father. Fifth Avenue Hotel, New York., April 4th, 1879. Dear Papa:

First day of Elisha Gray's Cross-Examination just concluded. Everything coming out in our favour. Counsel hope to obtain injunction inside of three weeks.

Delay your suits — and if you sell your patents — don't sell too cheap. It will all come out right.
