

Letter from Alexander Graham Bell to Mabel Hubbard Bell, undated, with transcript

Fitchburg Depot, Wednesday. Dear May,

Miss Locke would like you & Berta to meet her at my rooms in Beacon St. tomorrow at 3 o'clock.

I hear that Mrs. Sanders is very unwell & is about to leave for the South — so I intend running up to Salem after my lecture at the University tomorrow & Miss Locke will take my Reception Hour for me. Letter received from my mother. My father will be here Saturday morning.

I trust you all reached home safely last night.
