ALEXANDER GRAHAM BELL TO MABEL (Hubbard) BELL Parker House, Boston. March 9th, 1892. Dear Mabel:

Cannot write yet but hand improving. Can bend my thumb but forefinger still stiff. Just able to move it slightly.

Your Father and Mother returned to Washington this afternoon and I came on here to be with my Father. Hope to run down to Washington to see my Mother. Cannot write more.
