Letter from Mrs. Alexander Graham Bell to Dr. Alexander Graham Bell. (Postmarked Nov. 24, 1896) 1331 Connecticut Avenue, Washington, D.C. Dear Alec:

I enclose herewith letters from Papa. I replied in regard to the oil that I was interested in it and would like to venture the \$400.00 but that I had understood that you would not go into the speculation, and I could not therefore do anything in the matter without hearing from you.
