Present Owner: Miss Carrie B. Webb: From 1893 to present time.  
Previous Owners: A. F. Alexander: From 1836 to 1856.

Date of Erection: 1836.

Present Condition: Very good. The original structure remains intact, two rooms were added to the left rear about fifty years ago.

Number of Stories: Two.

Materials of Construction: Frame house with sheet metal roof, brick pillar foundation. It consists of four main rooms, two halls and two small rooms at the left rear. The interior walls are plastered, the exterior side and back walls are of 8" heart of pine weather-boarding. The front exterior walls are of plaster. The floors are of 8" heart of pine flooring. The stairway ascends the left side of the wall to the rear, across the rear, landing on the right side. There are four box columns. It has four French windows on the front, three colonial doors, one to each story on the front and the first floor on the rear. A small balcony over the front door with wooden railings is quite unique.
