

Description : Foundation: coursed ashlar stone perimeter walls ;
Structure : wood frame
Ext. walls: coved shiplap siding with plain corner boards
Roof: asphalt shingled, shallowly pitched gable; gabled and shed roofs over rear additions
Dormers: none
Windows: 1/1 double-hung with plain lintels, casings and slip sills
Porches: shed roofed open porch on south facade
Details: plain vergeboards and exposed rafter tips; plain board porch columns and balustrades

Construction Date: ca. 1915
Architecture Style: Basic Box
Statement of Significance: Built ca 1915, this simple frame house is typical of the vernacular structures erected in a neighborhood known historically as the East End (and presently as the Hampton Wedge). It is one of many small single-story cottages occupied primarily by blacks serving the households of the nearby town houses on Saint Louis and Walnut Streets.
